# The new fire extinguishing gadget



The Fire Services department is thinking of purchasing Elide Fire, the latest fire-extinguishing gadget to enter the market. Here's how it works:

#### WHAT IS ELIDE FIRE?

A ball, little less in size than a football. Weighing 1.3 kg, the ball is hurled into the fire. In a span of three to seven seconds, it releases chemicals to check the spread of flames,

eventually extinguishing the fire.

# WHOSE CREATION IS IT?

The fire-extinguishing technology is the brainchild of Woradech Kaimart of Thailand, Shree Shyam Bearings Private Limited



launched it in India on Thursday.

#### WHERE CAN IT BE USED?

The ball can cover a 1.296-m radius fire. It can also be installed in fire-prone zones like electrical circuit breakers, kitchens and storage sections to prevent fires. It contains dry chemicals, which create a blanket between the inflammable substance and air. The ball will be particularly effective in areas where there are logistical problems, like narrow approach lanes or dearth of water resources.

#### CANTUSEIT?

No special skills are required to operate the device. Easy to install, the red and yellow ball is self-activated, capable of extinguishing flames without human intervention.

#### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

When fire spreads, the extinguisher will sound out a 101 to 140 decibel fire alarm and then burst to extinguish the flames. No toxic chemicals are released into the environment.

# **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

The Elide Fire costs Rs 9,000 and has a fiveyear maintenance free shelf life.

### WHAT DOES THE MINISTER SAY?

State Fire and Emergency Services minister Pratim Chatterjee was satisfied with the device after a test trial. "It seems to be quite effective. We will decide whether to ac-
